Normal Scan: scans using a default setting, such as 600 dpi. Photo: scans at the highest resolution possible. Sepia: scans using an antique color effect Processor: The scan can be done using one of the following options: Two-Sided: scans one side at a time. This is most often used for documents because it's easier to scan on one side of the page. Contact Paper: scans one side at a time; using a specially treated paper that maintains color from one side to the other. This is often used for photos. Photo Continuous Feed: scans both sides at the same time. Positive-Negative: scans both sides at the same time; using two photos that are switched upside down. This is used to create mirror images of photos. File Format: choose a format 05a79cecff

Bullock Indicted For Second DUI December 29, 1985|By Thomas R. Allen, Staff Writer Bullock, a former member of the Seminole County Narcotics Task Force, was indicted for two misdemeanor DUIs, less than a year and a half after his conviction for the same offense. An unsealed indictment filed Dec. 23 in Seminole County State Court accuses Bullock of driving drunk July 21 on State Road A1A south of Melbourne Beach, failing to keep his vehicle in a single lane of traffic, driving a vehicle under the influence of alcohol, driving with a blood-alcohol level of .10 percent or greater and driving without a license in possession, the district attorney's office said. The indictment, filed three days after Bullock was released on \$500 bail, comes less than a year and a half after Bullock was convicted of DUI in Seminole County. In that case, he was sentenced to one year of probation, 75 hours of community service, 14 days of counseling and a \$250 fine. He has denied any drug or alcohol abuse. Bullock, 48, was arrested July 21 in Reedy Creek after a traffic stop for speeding. The officer smelled alcohol and a drug test later revealed Bullock's blood-alcohol level to be .16 percent, which is more than double the legal limit in Florida. On Nov. 22, the Florida Highway Patrol is scheduled to present its case against Bullock in the January trial of Joseph and Mary Ann Benson, who were cited for DUI after another traffic stop two months after Bullock's arrest.
